The Warren County Prosecutor's Office is seeking a Victim Advocate to provide advocacy to crime victims, in accordance with New Jersey Statute.

### Minimum requirements

- Applicants must have a Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university. (Applicants who do not possess the required education may substitute additional experience on a year-for-year basis.)
- Applicants will work with victims of domestic violence within the Municipal Court.
- Applicants will work in collaboration with Municipal Court Prosecutors, Administrators, Law Enforcement and victim: and must have the ability to establish and maintain cooperative working relationships with those involved with the case.
- Applicants must have the ability to work irregular work hours or be "on call" as needs warrant.
- Knowledge of the Criminal Justice System is preferred.
- Knowledge of the economic, social, and emotional effects likely to be encountered by crime victims is preferred.
- Applicants must have strong communication and problem solving skills.
- Applicants must successfully complete an employment background investigation.
