The Warren County Grand Jury returned an Indictment on February 26, 2014, against the above named individual. The Indictment includes six (6) counts and charges as follows:

- Three counts of Aggravated Sexual Assault, First Degree, for committing acts of sexual penetration upon a child less than thirteen (13) years of age. The three counts of Aggravated Sexual Assault allegedly occurred in Mansfield Township, Warren County, on or about January 7, 1988.
- Two counts of Sexual Assault, Second Degree, for committing acts of sexual contact with a child less than thirteen (13) years of age, and the defendant being four (4) years older than the victim. The two counts of Sexual Assault allegedly occurred in Mansfield Township, Warren County, on or about January 7, 1988.
- One count of Sexual Assault, second degree, for committing an act of sexual contact with a child less than thirteen (13) years of age, and the defendant being four (4) years older than the victim. This count relates to an incident which allegedly occurred in the town of Belvidere, Warren County, on or between December 18, 1986 and January 7, 1988.


A First Degree charge carries a maximum term of imprisonment of up to twenty (20) years in New Jersey State Prison. A second degree charge carries a maximum term of imprisonment of up to ten (10) years in New Jersey State Prison.

The investigation was conducted by the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit and the Warren County Major Crimes Unit, with assistance from the Warren County Sheriff's Department, Hackettstown Police Department and New Jersey State Police.

Please be advised that all of the charges are merely accusations and that the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
