The Warren County Grand Jury returned two indictments on April 3, 2013, against the above named individual. The first indictment includes eleven counts and charges:

- One count of Invasion of Privacy, third degree, which allegedly occurred in Hope Township, Warren County.
- Two counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, fourth degree, for possessing photographs or films with images of children engaged prohibited sexual acts. These charges relate to incidents in Hope Township, Warren County and Watchung, Somerset County, respectfully.
- Three counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, Second Degree, for photographing or filming a child engaged in a prohibited sexual act. These crimes occurred in Hope

Township, Warren County and Chester Township, Morris County, respectively.

- Two counts of Sexual Assault by Contact, second degree. The victim in each count is the same and was known to the defendant. These crimes occurred in Chester, Morris County and Watchung, Somerset County, respectively.
- Three Counts of Endangering the Welfare of a Child for sexual conduct which would impair or debauch the morals of a child. The victim is the same as that identified in the sexual assault charges.

The second indictment charges the defendant with one count of Possession of a Weapon by a Convicted Felon, second degree. The crime allegedly occurred in Watchung, Somerset County.


A second-degree crime carries a maximum term of imprisonment of up to ten (10) years New Jersey State Prison. A third-degree crime carries a maximum term of imprisonment of five (5) years New Jersey State Prison. A fourth-degree crime carries a maximum of eighteen (18) months New Jersey State Prison.

The defendant remains incarcerated at the Warren County Correctional Center in lieu of \$400,000 bail.

The investigation was conducted jointly by the New Jersey State Police and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit, with assistance from Somerset County Prosecutor's Office, Morris County

Prosecutor's Office, Hunterdon County Prosecutor's Office, Sussex
County Prosecutor's Office, New Jersey State Park Police, and the
Watchung Borough Police Department.

Please be advised that all of the charges are merely accusations
and that the defendant is presumed innocent until or unless proven
guilty.
