## PRESS RELEASE

Almost 30 years ago, the body of an unidentified, severely beaten female child "Princess Doe" was found murdered at the Cedar Ridge Cemetery in Blairstown, Warren County New Jersey. To this day "Princess Doe" has still not been identified. The Warren County Prosecutor's Office in conjunction with several missing children organizations and private citizens will be participating in a nondenominational memorial service at the Cedar Ridge Cemetery on **Sunday, July 15th at 12:00pm** (noon) at the Cedar Ridge Cemetery in Blairstown, New Jersey. The public is welcome and encouraged to attend.

The Warren County Prosecutor's Office Cold Case Unit along with other law enforcement agencies, have been working diligently to re-examine evidence in this investigation which they now believe will help lead to the identity of "Princess Doe" and the person or persons responsible for her murder. The Warren County Prosecutor's Office will reveal new information relative to this investigation at the memorial and discuss the advanced forensic techniques they are utilizing to solve this case.
