On Tuesday, January 19, 2016, Troopers from the New Jersey State Police, Washington Barracks responded to 94C U.S. 46, White Township, New Jersey in response to a 911 call regarding a male in distress. Upon arrival, Troopers found the victim, John Ranallo, unresponsive. Soon thereafter, Mr. Ranallo was pronounced deceased.

Preliminary investigation revealed that the victim, John Ranallo and a friend responded to the above address for the purpose of picking up his daughter. Soon after his arrival, the alleged assailant, Steven Segarra, age 37, motioned to the victim to exit the home. After a brief discussion, Steven Segarra struck the victim in the face knocking him down. He then mounted the victim and repeatedly struck him about the face. After the attack, the victim re-entered the home and collapsed, never to regain consciousness. Moments after the victim collapsed, Steven Segarra and a female by the name of Charity Bucey fled the scene in her Grey Acura MDX SUV. Steven Segarra and Charity Bucey were located at the Canadian border in New York State

The initial investigation was conducted by the New Jersey State Police Major Crimes Unit, New Jersey State Police, Washington Barracks, and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office. The continuing investigation of the incident is being conducted by the New Jersey State Police and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office Major Crime Unit.

Steven Segarra has been charged with Aggravated Manslaughter in the First Degree. That Charge carries a maximum penalty of thirty (30) years in New Jersey State Prison.

Please be advised that the charges are merely accusations and the defendant is presumed innocent of all charges unless and until proven guilty.
