
PRESS RELEASE

Guilty Plea: Greivin Estrada

On September 19, 2016, Greivin Estrada plead guilty to one count of Aggravated Sexual Assault, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:14-2a(1), a crime of the first degree, for committing acts of sexual penetration with a child less than thirteen (13) years old. The Defendant also plead guilty to one count Eluding, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 2C:29-2b, a crime of the second degree, and one count of Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Cocaine), in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1)/2c:35-5b(2), a crime of the second degree. In a separate accusation, the Defendant plead guilty to Witness Tampering, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-5d, a crime of the second degree. One count of Endangering the Welfare of a Child, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-4a, a crime of the second degree; one count of Possession of Controlled Dangerous Substance, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), a crime of the third degree; as well as various motor vehicle tickets were dismissed by the State in exchange for the guilty plea.

The terms of the plea agreement include fifteen (15) years New Jersey State Prison with a twelve (12) year nine (9) month mandatory minimum period of parole ineligibility pursuant to the No Early Release Act. The Defendant will be subject to Parole Supervision for Life and Megan's Law. A restraining order will be entered and the Defendant must be examined at the Adult Diagnostic and Treatment Center to determine if his behavior is deemed repetitive and compulsive. As part of the plea agreement, the Defendant admitted to engaging in sexual penetration with a twelve (12) year old girl that was known to him. The Defendant also admitted to eluding law enforcement, possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute and witness tampering by offering a witness a benefit in consideration of the witness withholding testimony. Sentencing is scheduled for October 28, 2016. The plea was entered before the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C., in Belvidere.
