On September 30, 2016, Nan S. Paek, Myung C. Lee, and Young Ja Yang were charged with various prostitution-related offenses following a three month undercover investigation into ongoing prostitution at Red Tree Massage, 18 W. Washington Avenue, Washington N.J. The investigation was conducted by the Washington Township Police Department and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office-Narcotics Task Force. A search warrant was executed at the above business, and evidence of sexual activity was discovered, including some hidden behind insulation in the building.

Nan S. Paek is charged with:

1. One (1) count of promoting prostitution, a fourth degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:34-1b, and
2. One (1) count of maintaining a place for prostitution, a fourth degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:33-12c.

Myung C. Lee is charged with:

1. One (1) count of promoting prostitution, a fourth degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:34-1b.

Young Ja Yang is charged with:

1. One (1) count of engaging in prostitution, a disorderly person offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:24-1b(8).

Each fourth degree crime carries a maximum penalty of 18 months in New Jersey State Prison and or a fine of \$10,000. A disorderly persons offense carries a maximum penalty of six months in jail and or a fine of \$1,000.

Paek's first appearance on the charges was held Monday, October 3, 2016 at the Warren County Court House.

Myung Lee's first appearance on the charges was held Tuesday, October 11, 2016 at the Warren County Court House.

Please be advised that all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
