On October 14, 2016, Paul J. Madlock and Alisha Zeigler were charged with various narcotics related offenses following a one month undercover investigation into the distribution of controlled dangerous substances. The investigation was conducted by the Phillipsburg Police Department, Drug Enforcement Administration and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office, Narcotics Task Force. The Warren County Tactical Response Team assisted in executing the search warrant at the defendants' residence.

Paul J. Madlock is charged with:

1. One (1) count of distribution of a controlled dangerous substance; to wit, methamphetamine, a second degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(9)(a), and
2. One (1) count of possession with the intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance; to wit, methamphetamine, a second degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(9)(a), and
3. One (1) count of possession of a controlled dangerous substance; to wit, methamphetamine, a third degree crime in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1).

Alisha Zeigler is charged with:

1. One (1) count of possession of a controlled dangerous substance; to wit, trazadone, a fourth degree offense in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), and
2. One (1) count of possession of a controlled dangerous substance; to wit, lorazapan, a fourth degree crime in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(1), and
3. One (1) count of possession of a prescription legend drug; to wit, busiprone, a fourth degree crime in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10.5e(2)

Each second degree crime carries a maximum penalty of ten years in New Jersey State Prison and or a fine of \$150,000. Each third degree crime carries a maximum penalty of five years in New Jersey State Prison and or a fine of \$35,000. Each fourth degree crime carries a maximum penalty of 18 months in New Jersey State Prison and or a fine of \$10,000. A disorderly persons offense carries a maximum penalty of six months in jail and or a fine of \$1,000.

Madlock and Zeigler's first appearance on the charges was held Monday October 24, 2016 at the Warren County Court House.

Please be advised that all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
