On July 20, 2017, the above-named individual was admitted into the Pre-Trial Intervention Program ("PTI") for 24 months by the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C. This resolution was part of a negotiated plea agreement with the Warren County Prosecutor's Office, Special Victims Unit, who also worked with the Attorney General's Office - Division of Law, on behalf of the Division of Consumer Affairs. In exchange for defendant's admission into "PTI" for 2 years, the defendant has agreed to the standard PTI conditions as well as to the following additional conditions:

- Defendant agrees to the revocation of his license to practice as a chiropractor in the State of New Jersey and to a permanent bar on his holding of any professional license in the State of New Jersey.
- Defendant agrees that the above two licensure conditions survive defendant's potential successful discharge from PTI after the 2 years has expired.
- Defendant agrees to consent to and formally sign a Consent Order of Revocation of his right to practice as a chiropractor, prepared by the Attorney General's Office, by no later than September 1, 2017, and further agrees to abide by all terms and conditions contained therein.
- Defendant shall permanently cease and desist from all patient contact in the State of New Jersey. This limitation includes, but is not limited to, the rendering of chiropractic examination, treatment, or care, massage, yoga and/or rehabilitation services such as stretching and exercise.
- Defendant shall have no contact with victims M.M. and S.M.S.

This case stemmed from complaints filed by two separate victims alleging that the defendant committed criminal sexual contact with them, one victim by using his hand to rub her vagina over her clothing without her consent, and with the other victim held and squeezed the bare breast of the second victim with his bare hand without her consent.

Prior to this resolution, the Honorable H. Matthew Curry, J.S.C., released defendant on his own recognizance with the following conditions: 1) Comply with the New Jersey Chiropractic Licensing Board Recommendations and 2) No contact with the victims.
