Acting Warren County Prosecutor Anthony Picione, Acting Chief of Detectives Brenton Warne, and Phillipsburg Police Department Police Chief Robert Stettner announce that on August 6, 2024, Cameron M. Scrudato, age 46, of Inverness Florida, pleaded guilty prior to the commencement of trial to:

1. Sexual Assault, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C: 14-2b, a crime of the Second Degree.


The sexual act occurred in July 2018 in Phillipsburg, New Jersey, when the victim was 6 years old.

The Honorable John J. Burke, III, J.S.C. accepted the guilty plea. Scrudato is tentatively scheduled for sentencing on October 18, 2024. Per the plea agreement, the State will recommend Scrudato be sentenced to 10 years New Jersey State Prison, subject to the No Early Release Act, meaning that he would not be eligible for release until he serves 85% of his sentence. Scrudato will also be subject to registration pursuant to Megan's Law and Parole Supervision for Life. He is also responsible for the costs expended by the County in extraditing him.

The State was represented by S.D.A.G. / Acting Assistant Prosecutors Carolynn O'Dell and Gloria Rispoli. Acting Prosecutor Picione commended both of the Acting Assistant Prosecutors, along with detectives from the Phillipsburg Police Department and the Warren County Prosecutor's Office, for their outstanding work in investigating and prosecuting this case. Acting Prosecutor Picione would also like to thank the Phillipsburg Police Department, Warren County Prosecutor's Office Special Victims Unit, Warren County Department of Corrections, Citrus County Sheriff's Office (FL) and the Office of the District Attorney General in Maryville (TN) for their efforts in this case.
