On Tuesday, July 30, 2024, at approximately 11:39 AM, the Greenwich Township Police Department responded to the TD Bank located on State Highway 22 for a report of an individual utilizing fraudulent information to obtain a TD Bank credit card. Upon patrols arrival, an individual matching the description of the suspect was located. During the course of the investigation, Luis A. Godoy was identified as the suspect, arrested, and charged as follows;

- 1) Forgery, specifically by attempting to alter the victim's TD Bank account information, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-1a(1), a crime of the third degree.
- 2) Presented a False Government Document, specifically a New Jersey Drivers License, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-2.1c, a crime of the third degree.
- 3) Impersonating Another, with the purpose to benefit himself or another or to injure or defraud another, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:21-17a(1), a crime of the fourth degree.

Third degree crimes carry a maximum sentence of 5 years in New Jersey State Prison, and fourth degree crimes carry a maximum sentence of 18 months in New Jersey State Prison.

The charges are merely accusations. The defendant is presumed innocent **until and unless** proven guilty beyond a reasonable doubt in a court of law.

The investigation was conducted by the Greenwich Township Police Department.
